## 3 pm Safety—Pathway to classrooms

It is vital we maintain strict levels of safety, not just on the surrounding roads but also in the school grounds themselves. Classrooms are located a fair distance from the main administration and quadrangle areas. In the afternoons parents are requested to wait in the COLA / asphalt area, basketball court or outside the gate on Warnervale Rd for their children. NO waiting is permitted outside classrooms. Please DO NOT wait on the pathway or the classroom steps of the demountable classrooms. The main pathway is very crowded with waiting parents, pre-schoolers and prams and I am concerned that an accident may occur. This is a safety requirement as all children will be leaving from the same main pathway. The pathway needs to be clear at all times to allow access.

## Attendance

All schools in NSW must monitor attendance and have procedures in place for students that have significant attendance issues. There have already been a number of students that have unexplained absences. The Education Act requires explanation to be made within 7 days for any absence from school. Please provide a reason for any absence on the day your child returns: utilise the Flexibuzz App or call the office to provide an explanation.

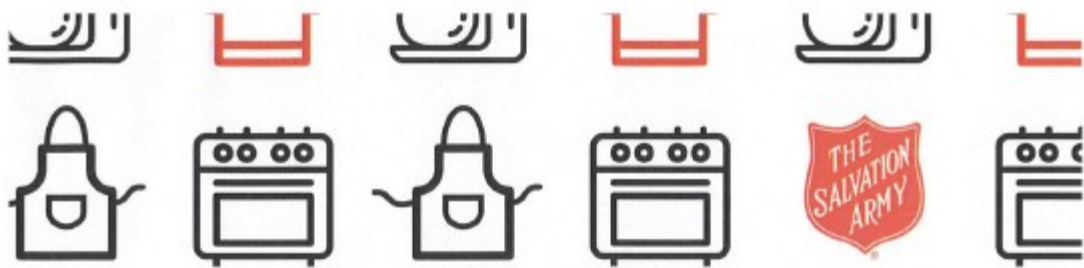
